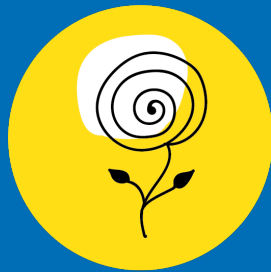

HOW TO THINK/TALK PEACE?

NEGATIVE PEACE

Direct physical violence is absent (Galtung, 1996).

POSITIVE PEACE

One can experience social justice, see relations nonviolently develop, while there are ongoing and effective efforts to reduce cultural and structural violence too (Galtung, 1996).

QUALITY PEACE

A post-war arrangement that is context-specifically designed in a way for further violence to be prevented; this arrangement has three pillars: dignity, security and predictability (Wallensteen, 2015).

Peacebuilding is ...
"work to reduce violence by peaceful means"

(J.Galtung, 1996, p.9)

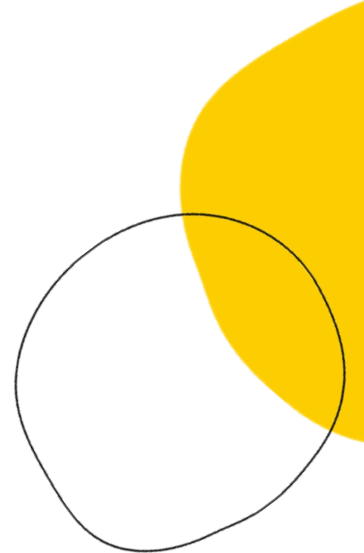

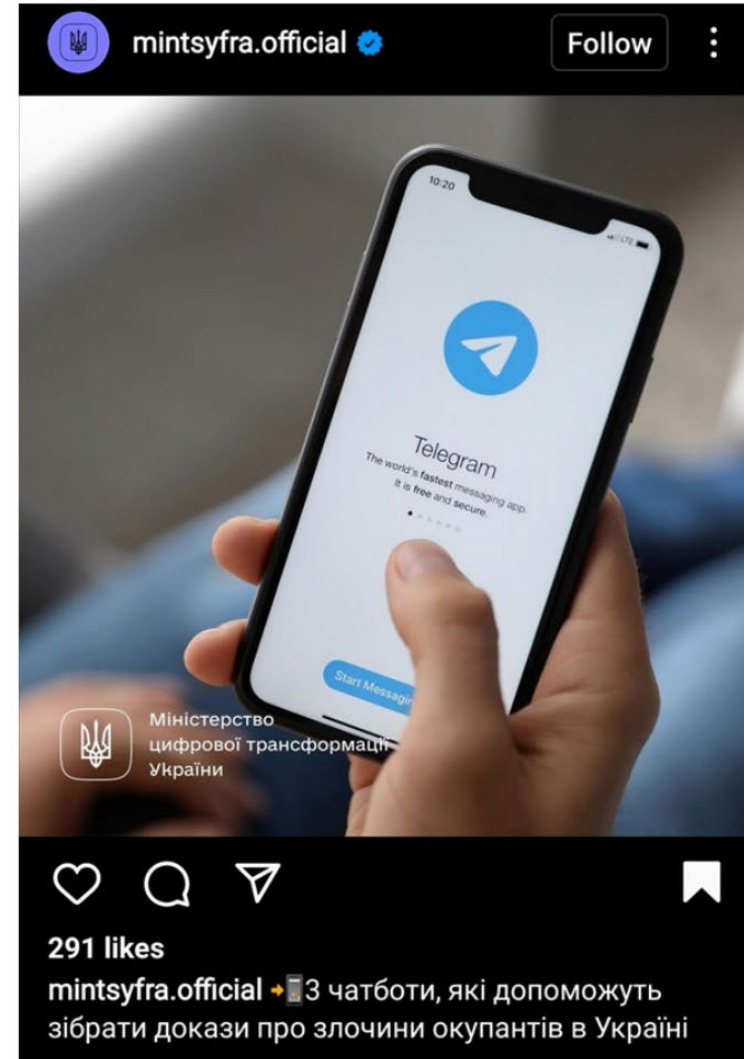
3 chat-bots to report & document Russia's war crimes in Ukraine

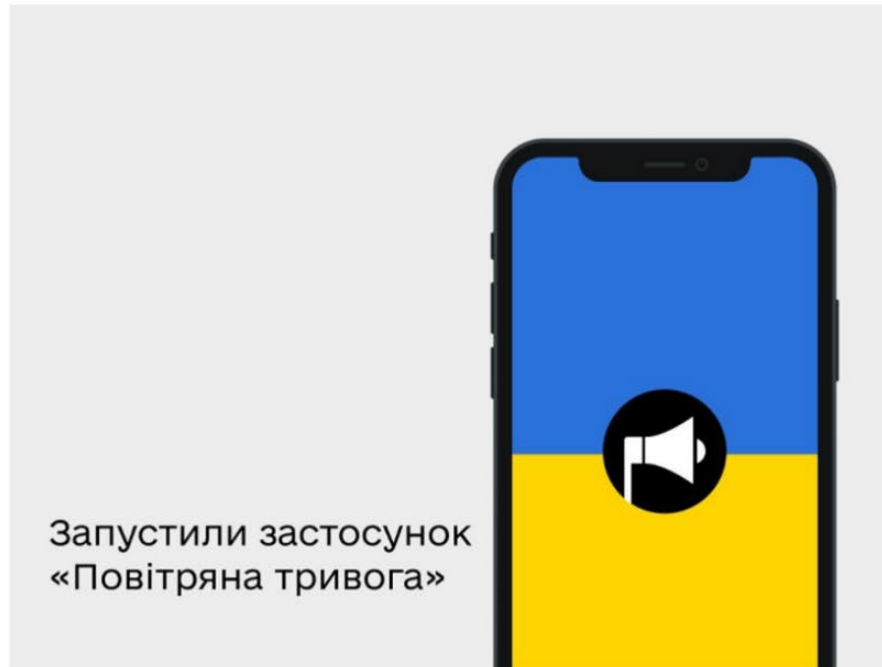

The app sends strong notifications of air danger and other kinds of danger (e.g. chemical) even when the phone is on silent/sleeping mode.
