- Are you available during the 4-day training event from 26-29th
 September 2025?
- Can you commit to holding at least one T4T during the term 2025-2026?
- Are you interested to engage with the network throughout the year?
- Do you have timely capacities for further exchange with other peer educators throughout the year?

- We welcome applications from all young people, regardless of nationality, residence status, religion, class, gender, sexual orientation, or disability. As a positive measure against socially existing disadvantages (§5 Allgemeines Gleichbehandlungsgesetz), we particularly welcome applications from Black people, people of colour, people with experience of racism or discrimination and/or applicants with a history of flight or family migration.

The deadline for applications is Sunday, 25th May 2025, 23:59 CEST.

Please register via the same application-link and follow the application for experienced Peer Educators. Please be aware that we expect you to participate at the European Summer School 2025.
